I have contacted the local aluminum companies and am getting information on what structural members are available in aluminum before attacking the design of the rolling cover. Aluminum, while costing considerably more initially, should show a long run saving in maintenance costs. I also will discuss the idea on the coast with some other Paddock men to get their ideas. I have a local structural engineer who will work with me on the project with the idea that only if we decide to build the cover, will he receive a nominal commission.

I will be in touch with you by mid-February with further details and a pool proposal.
