I have been in Van Hornesville this past week and have tried every day to get in touch with you by telephone. I had several minor questions, but the main one was to find out if the way was clear to proceed with grading around the pool.

Apparently the last crew here did not quite complete the coping and tile installation, the circular seat in the wading pool, the fresh water line to the fillspout, and some of the connections of the 3 inch return to the pool.

Mr. Dayton DeLong of Herkimer plans to do the rough grading next week and we will proceed with the gravel topping and decks as soon as possible thereafter. Are there any precautions you wish to give us on protection of your plastic piping? If so, would you send me a note to Princeton with a copy to my brother Richard at Van Hornesville.

He is sending you today the check for the second installment.

Various members of the family who have seen the pool are delighted with the shape and size and, of course, are pressing to get it completed.
